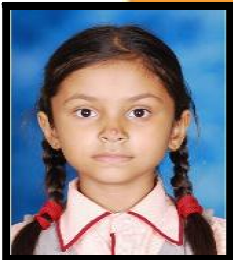

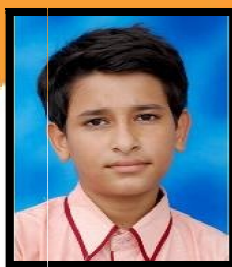

Leadership Camp

Activities conducted in the school for sensitizing the students for the environment protection:

A number of activities were conducted in the school. Eco club of the school works towards spreading and strengthening the green habits amongst the children, parents and general public.

1. **Sagar Mitra:** Sagar Mitra Project is a yearlong project in which the children educate others for the wise use of plastic. They collect the plastic waste at their home and bring it to school on the last working Saturday of the month for renewal. They emphasize on the three R's –Reduce –Reuse–Renew.
2. **Plantation Drive:** A number of trees were planted by the children during Van-Mahotsava week. A guest lecture was held to educate the children for the protection and plantation of trees.
 - a. **Vermi compost pit** - There is a Vermicompost pit in our sensory garden. The chief objective is to compost organic wastes and to produce superior quality manure to feed our nutrient hungry soil. Vermicomposting is a method of preparing enriched compost with the use of earthworms. Vermicompost is earthworm excrement called castings which can improve the quality of soil.
3. **Best out of waste activity:** Children enthusiastically participate in best out of waste activities. Waste materials are recycled to make something new. It is fun and a creative way to keep our children occupied in their waste management projects. It is a great way to reduce the waste and do the planet and self a favour.
4. **Segregation of waste:** In our school waste is segregated. “Waste Segregation” means dividing waste into dry and wet. Dry waste includes wood, metals, glass and other products. Wet wastes typically refer to organic waste. Effective segregation to waste means that less waste goes to landfill which makes it cheaper and better for people and the environment. Our students are encouraged to become environment friendly.

5. **Skit on environment day:** A skit competition was held on the Environment Day. The main aim was to give Environmental Education through drama. A special cleanliness drive was carried out to reverberate to the mission. The students took a pledge to clean their school, homes and surroundings. Students were given handy tips to keep their surroundings and school clean. Plastic bags are plague to the environment and oceans. Children are taught to fight against this pollution.
8. **Eco friendly Diwali:** ECO – Friendly Diwali: - This message was conveyed by our respected Principal Ma'am Mrs. Vandana Singh. She gave a speech on 'Eco-friendly Diwali' in the assembly. An eco-friendly Diwali celebration is nothing but celebrating in a way that does not cause harm to our eco-system. One can start by just lighting diyas and avoiding loud and smoke filled firecrackers. Crackers create unwanted noise and cause air pollution. All the students were encouraged to celebrate an environmentally safe and secured Diwali.
9. **Participation in health marathon:** Participation in health Marathon: - Our children participated in health Marathon with teachers and our respected principal Ma'am. Students were motivated for maximum participation. With the growing consciousness about fitness and good health, running a marathon occupies a prime position. Running improves aerobic fitness and is a great way to improve cardiovascular health. It burns calories and builds strength. Running relieves stress and strengthens lungs and over-all immune system.
